PET ASSIST

You may be familiar with the enzyme-containing product Pet Assist that has been used by numerous vets and their clients as a non-antimicrobial treatment for digestive upsets in reducing liquid faecal consistency, and to improve digestive efficiency associated with digestive stress in dogs.

Please note that the appearance of the product has changed slightly from a beige powder with brown granules in it to an off-white coloured powder with brown granules. This may be noticed by owners when dispensing it to pets. It should not be a cause for concern as the product still meets all of its specifications concerning the enzyme content.

The reason for this change is that the primary supplier of the enzymes discontinued the enzyme blend which we used to purchase, and replaced it with an improved enzyme specification raw material. This is the main reason for the change in colour. The enzymes that are included are predominantly used in pig and poultry nutrition. We are dependent upon gaining access to this raw material because our volume of requirement is extremely small - compared to the animal feed industry.
